FAQuestions:

How many orientations do I have to attend?

- I am enrolled in multiple online courses...
 Answer: Attendance at only one orientation is required.
- I have <u>successfully</u> taken online classes in the past...

 Answer: You may be excused from the "mandatory orientation." I do expect you to read the syllabus thoroughly, complete the free sample class (follow the directions below re: submitting the certificate of completion to me), and take the Orientation Quiz- once D2L opens.

When does the Online Class open in D2L?

- Students will not have access to their D2L Class until Orientation. At that point you will see the link to your class, if you are registered.
- In the meantime students can complete the following:
- 1.) <u>Update Your Los Rios iMail (Forward SCC Email to an account you regularly use).</u>

AND.

2.) ALL STUDENTS must read their COURSE SYLLABUS and complete the D2L Free Sample Class BEFORE attending their ORIENTATION:

Where Is The Free D2L Sample Class?

When you first enter D2L (**My Home** Area- before clicking on your class site), look for the link that says "**Self-Registration.**"

- Click on "Self-Registration"
- Click on "Free Sample Class for Students"
- Click on "Register"

After completing the "Free Sample Class for Students" (All 5 modules):

- You will receive notice that you completed the course, with an option to print out your own certificate of completion.
- Save your certificate in "rich text format" and upload it to the D2L Dropbox for your class(es).
- If you follow the above instructions correctly, you will receive 5 extra credit points!

ADDING A COURSE

Students who are **NOT ENROLLED** include:

- Students who are **ON THE WAITING LIST**; and
- Students who just <u>WANT TO ADD</u> a new class
- The above students must also complete the D2L Sample Class <u>and</u> attend the course Orientation. Add numbers will be handed out (if there is space available) for the desired course(s). No exceptions. No guarantees.
- Add numbers will NOT be available before <u>Orientation</u>, (see times listed by course below).
