You can benefit our community by educating children in valuable safety, health, nutrition, and fitness awareness.

Safetyville provides an opportunity for you to gain hands on experience working with and educating children. It is a great way for you to give back to the community by teaching children life lessons in safety, nutrition, health, and fitness awareness. Safetyville offers free training, a positive work environment, letters of recommendation, and an experience to last a lifetime.

Safetyville USA is a program of the Safety Center Incorporated, which is an affiliate of the National Safety Council, and a private, not for Profit Corporation.

Since Safetyville USAs opening in 1984, over 200,000 children have toured the village. Safetyville USA is a typical American town built at 1/3 scale. This three-acre outdoor site is complete with streets, sidewalks, working traffic signals, a gas station, a school, police and fire stations, homes, office buildings and shops. Interactive stations provide learning experiences in street safety, animal safety, health, nutrition, exercise awareness and more.

Any group of ten or more children, age four through third grade can tour the village (\$2.00 per person). Safetyville USA has been a popular fieldtrip destination for elementary schools and scout troops for over 25 years.

As a trained volunteer docent you will sign-up to lead at least one-one hour tour per week, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Safetyville also (utilizes volunteers) when it sponsors special events that occur outside of the normal operating hours such as a Family Safety and Health Expo, Halloween Haunt, Taste of the Little City and Birthday Parties.
